


Warranty Approved Truck Installation Guide

- Chock wheels of equipment release the brakes and do a proper brake adjustment and component inspection.
- > Remove any existing brake stroke indicators.
- > Install the mounting bracket on the maxi brake chamber stud.
- > Trucks at the 6 o'clock position.
- Using grease, lube the sensor threads and push button, lube inside the cap and the outside of the cap. <u>THIS IS A MUST.</u>
- > Assemble the sensor to the mounting bracket as follows, sensor, bracket, nut, O-ring and cap.
- > Apply full service side air brake pressure (not parking brakes)
- > Attach the sensor bracket to the mounting bracket using the provided 1/4 inch nuts and bolts.
- Slide the sensor bracket to just touch the slack adjuster and tighten the 1/4 inch nut and bolt.
- > Install the wire harness securing it away from any moving parts using the provided nylon ties.
- > Secure all sensor connections to the bracket mount using the supplied nylon ties.
- > Follow the airlines to the front of the truck.

Truck Electrical Connections

- Choose where the light will go in the dashboard. Drill a 1/2" inch hole for the light. Run the 2 conductor wire with no plug and play ends on it inside the firewall and into the truck cab.
- > Attach the white wire to ground and attach the black wire to the black lead of the light.
- > Attach the red lead of the light to key on/off power source.
